

Similar types of support are sometimes offered with online tax preparation software for a fee. In either case, if you're required to pay more tax, the bill may get passed on to you.

> Don't let fear cost you. Some taxpayers shy away from claiming legitimate credits and deductions because they fear an audit. That could be a costly choice. There's only a small chance you'll get audited, and it could be quick and relatively painless - especially if you keep good records.

> Fear also leads thousands of people to fall victim to taxrelated scams. Thieves may impersonate an IRS agent, but the IRS will never call or email you requesting a specific type of payment. The IRS only initiates contact with taxpayers by mail, and you can choose among several methods of payment when you owe money.

> Bottom line: While there's no way to guarantee the IRS won't ask questions about your tax return, don't let fear of an audit keep you from using the credits or deductions you can rightfully claim. Filing a complete and accurate return could help minimize your chances of an audit, and if you do receive a notice, you may be able to quickly resolve the issue by following the instructions.

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



• On April 10, 1972, British film pioneer Charlie Chaplin accepts honorary an Academy Award for his "incalculable" contribution to the art of filmmaking. Chaplin had left the U.S. in 1952 for failure to pay taxes and McCarthy-era accusations. He came back long enough to accept the award.

• On April 11, 1968, rescue workers pick up the last survivors of the Wahine ferry disaster off the coast of Wellington, New Zealand. The ferry had capsized the previous day after hitting sharp rocks, leaving 53 people dead.

• On April 12, 1888, Cecil Kimber, founder of the British sports car company MG, is born in England. Following World War II, returning American soldiers who had become fans of MGs while serving in Europe helped popularize the brand in the U.S.

• On April 13, 1997, 21-year-old Tiger Woods wins the prestigious Masters Tournament by a record 12 strokes in Augusta, Georgia, in the greatest performance by a professional golfer in more than a century.

• On April 14, 1865, John Wilkes Booth, an actor and Confederate sympathizer, fatally shoots President Abraham Lincoln during a play at Ford's Theater in Washington, D.C. The attack came only five days after Confederate Gen. Robert E. Lee surrendered, effectively ending the Civil War.


