TASB picks Rodriguez

Canutillo ISD Trustee Armando Rodriguez has been named Secretary-Treasurer for the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB). Rodriguez is just the fourth trustee from Region 19 to serve as an officer on the TASB Board of Directors since David Sublasky of Fabens ISD in 1997-98. Only two other El Paso area trustees have served as TASB officers - Ross Borrett, Ysleta ISD, 1975-76; and Ted Andress, El Paso ISD 1958-59. UTEP heads consortium focused on substance abuse

EL PASO COUNTY – After the recent completion of a substance abuse and Texas' Health Service Region 10 consortium of community partners is now leading an effort to develop workforce, service delivery, and sustainability plans that focus on prevention, treatment and

University of Texas at El Paso's (UTEP) Minority AIDS Research Center (MARC), which is the sub-recipient of a \$1 million implementation grant to target substance use disorders and opioid use disorders in the five rural counties that are located along the Texas-Mexico border.

UTEP's MARC is one of five regional consortium partners led by Aliviane Inc., the principal recipient of the grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA) Rural Communities Opioid Response Program. Other partners include the Texas State Department of Health Services Office of Border Public Health, Presidio County


Health Services, and the Center Against Sexual and Family Violence.

According to officials with Aliviane, a nonprofit drug treatment center, residents of these five border counties are at high risk for substance use and opioid use prevention needs assessment in West disorder based on the region's low socioeconomic status, lack of access to health including Hudspeth, Culberson, Presidio, care, transportation availability barriers, Brewster, and Jeff Davis counties – a immigration policy-related barriers, proximity to violence, accessibility to drugs, shortages of health care professionals, and a lack of health literacy initiatives.

The consortium's plans are to Spearheading the collaborative is the implement prevention, treatment, and recovery services for substance abuse and opioid use disorders through Region 10's public health services network of current providers.

> "During the planning phase of this grant, our consortium successfully assessed the need for prevention, treatment and recovery services for people with substance and opioid abuse disorders and developed a strategic and workforce development plan for these five Texas rural counties," stated Thenral Mangadu, M.D., Ph.D., UTEP associate professor of public health sciences and MARC's executive director.

Rural Communities Opioid Response Program, our consortium will be the main interdisciplinary service provider for substance use disorders and opioid use disorders in the region," the UTEP professor asserted.

Mangadu noted that nearly 25,000 residents, mostly Mexican Americans, live in these five West Texas rural counties and that the area has been designated a federal Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) for its lack of providers. She pointed out that about 37 percent of residents are uninsured, and 22 percent live below the poverty line.

In August, HRSA, an agency within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, awarded over \$101 million to 116 organizations in 42 states and the District of Columbia to combat substance use disorders and opioid use disorders. Aliviane was one of three Texas organizations to receive the award.

"The rural counties of Hudspeth, Culberson, Presidio, Brewster and Jeff Davis have limited to no access to lifesaving substance use disorder (SUD) or opioid use disorder (OUD) prevention and treatment services," Aliviane Inc. chief executive officer Ivonne Tapia told reporters recently.

Tapia stated that through the consortium, partners will be able to leverage resources and expand access to SUD/OUD prevention, treatment, recovery support services, a trained workforce, and the creation of a sustainability plan aimed at reducing cost of care for individuals living in the targeted rural counties. She added that plans also call for addressing the risk of HIV, hepatitis C virus and mental health disparities associated with substance use disorders and opioid use disorders.

Social Security bumpsbenefits by 1.3 percent starting 2021

Social Security Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits for approximately 70 million Americans will increase 1.3 percent in 2021, the Social Security Administration announced today.

The 1.3 percent cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) will begin with benefits payable to more than 64 million Social Security beneficiaries in January 2021. Increased payments to more than 8 million SSI beneficiaries will begin on December 31, 2020. (Note: some people receive both Social Security and



SSI benefits). The Social Security Act ties the annual COLA to the increase in the Consumer Price Index as determined by the Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Some other adjustments that take effect in January of each year are based on the increase in average wages. Based on that increase, the maximum amount of earnings subject to the Social Security tax (taxable maximum) will increase to \$142,800 from \$137,700.

Social Security and SSI beneficiaries are normally notified by mail starting in early December about their new benefit amount. Most COLA is calculated. To read more, please visit people who receive Social Security payments www.socialsecurity.gov/cola.




















Cologuard test worth risk of false positive

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 77-year-old man in good health. At my recent annual physical exam, my physician ordered a Cologuard

kit to be sent to me to screen for colorectal disease. I have never had symptoms of disease or problems with any part of my gastrointestinal tract. I had two colonoscopies at different times several years ago, the results of which were negative. When I got the kit, I read the patient guidelines and learned that the Cologuard test could result in false positives and that there is



an unspecified increase in the risk of false positives for persons over the age of 75. A positive result from the test requires a follow-up colonoscopy, which is also riskier for elderly patients. Since I am in good health with no symptoms of any disease, I decided I did not want to risk a false positive result from the test, which would require a follow-up colonoscopy. Did I make the right decision? – E.G.

Cologuard is a brand of test that looks at DNA in stool for evidence of cancer. Certain DNA mutations are highly suggestive of cancer. In addition, Cologuard does an immunochemical test looking for blood. Because it combines these two techniques, Cologuard is more sensitive than only a test looking for blood. Compared with colonoscopy, Cologuard is about 92% sensitive in finding cancers, meaning it will miss about 8%.

With improved sensitivity comes a lack of specificity, which means you could have a false positive result. The Cologuard can say that you have an abnormality when a colonoscopy would indicate normal. For 45% of people with a positive Cologuard test, no abnormalities will be found upon colonoscopy. You are right that false positives are more prevalent in older individuals.

There are two reasons that I think the Cologuard is still a reasonable choice, despite the fact that it isn't as good as colonoscopy. The first is that I continue to recommend a screening test for healthy 77-year-old men, and although colonoscopy is my first choice, a normal Cologuard test prevents a need for colonoscopy, and a false positive would lead to the same colonoscopy you would have gotten anyway (although there probably is more anxiety after a false positive test).

The second is that a person with an abnormal Cologuard and a normal colonoscopy may be at risk for an abnormality that wasn't found on colonoscopy. A study looking at people in this category found a 25% risk of abnormality on follow-up colonoscopy, if the Cologuard was abnormal again one to two years later.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I had lung surgery in 2014. The scar is still red and sore. I got no instructions on how to deal with it. Do you have any suggestions? – J.S.B.

That's a very long time for the scar to still be red and sore, and I would encourage you to have the surgeon or your regular doctor take a look. For people with redness and soreness in a scar shortly after surgery, I recommend silicone gel (there are many available), as it has been shown to be effective. Many people recommend vitamin E oil, but well-done studies have shown this does not help and may harm the cosmetic appearance.


