



## Group promotes peace and unity through art

*Martinez' "Dream Monster" mural adorns building wall*

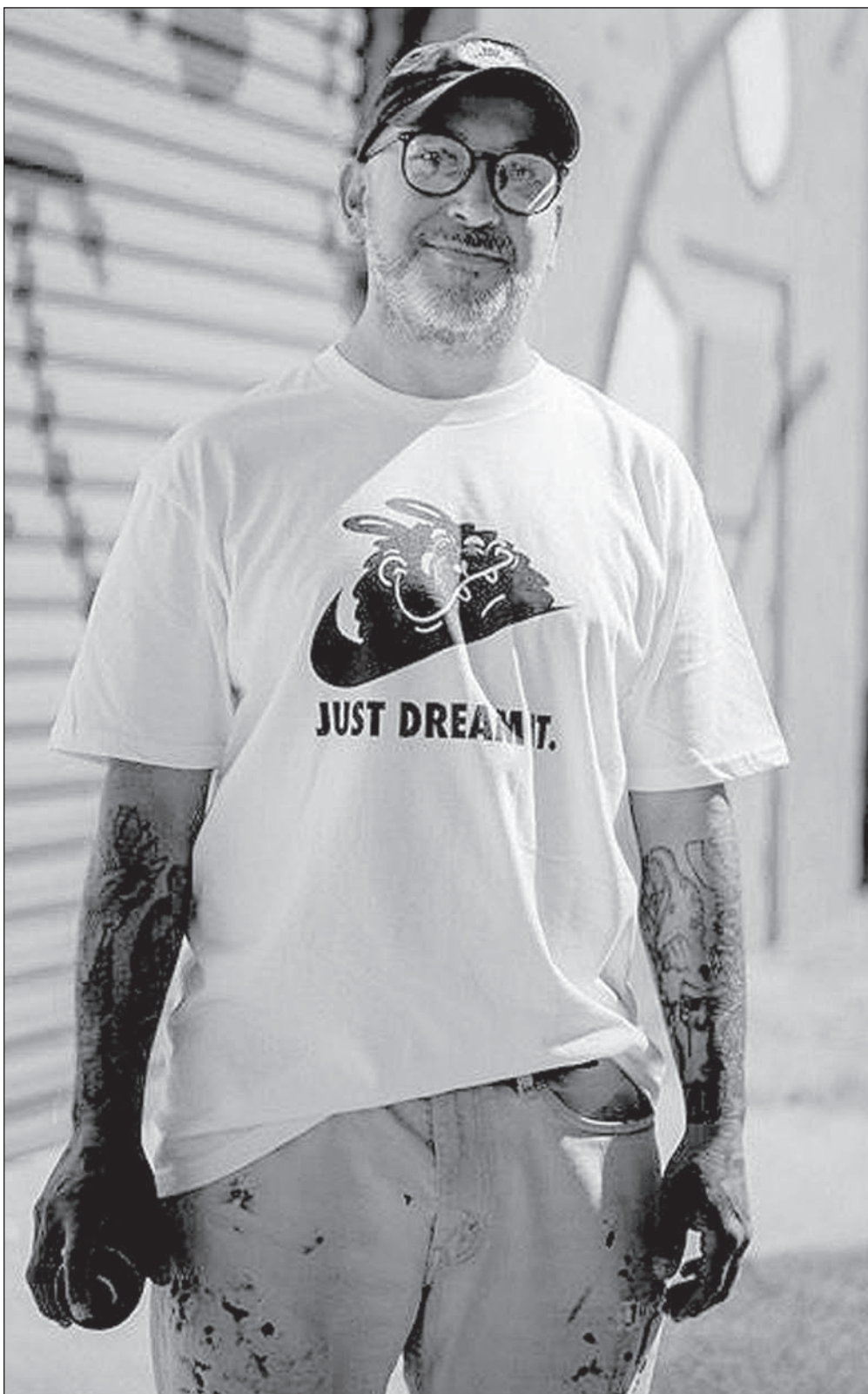

EL PASO COUNTY – The recent unveiling event of the World Peace Day mural in El Paso County's lower valley highlighted the Search for Common Ground (SCG) organization's stated mission, which is to transform the way the world deals with conflict, away from adversarial approaches and toward cooperative solutions.

Now gracing the wall of a Del Norte Courts Motel building, located at 4015 Alameda Ave, is the curious mural painted by local artist Matthew Jay Martinez. The special artwork, created in partnership with the SCG group, emphasizes the non-profit's themes of peace, unity, and togetherness, with the artist's distinct creation, the Dream Monster which serves as a central character in the mural.

Since 1982, SCG has worked to end violent conflict and to build healthy,

safe, and just societies all over the world, according to its website, and that the organization works in 35 countries across Africa, Asia, Europe, the Middle East, North and South America.

Celebrating World Peace Day in El Paso with the unveiling of Martinez's new mural heralded SCG's presence in the borderland community and brought attention to its work of using everything – from traditional diplomacy and mediation to video games and virtual exchange – to change the nature of conflict, from a destructive force to a constructive one whenever, where ever necessary, event

organizers purported.

"Instead of approaching conflict from a win-lose perspective, John Marks, founder of Search for Common Ground, introduced a new concept that claims that 'we all win when the focus is on what we want to achieve, not what divides us,'" Martinez related.

On hand for the event was SCG's media production division, which reaches millions of people worldwide, through films, reality TV, music videos, video games, comic books, and more.

"World Peace Day (September 21), recognized globally, is a time to reflect on harmony and shared understanding across cultures, and the addition of this mural aims to create a permanent

reminder of these values within the El Paso community," Martinez stated.

The local artist is known for his clean and whimsical style that evokes happiness, and his signature character – The Dream Monster – has appeared in public artworks across the region. His work has been featured in festivals, galleries, and on murals throughout the country.

With over 20 years of experience in the art world, Martinez acknowledged that his creations embody a sense of optimism and community as he works to expand his use of various media including murals, canvas, wood cutouts, and screen prints.

In addition to his personal projects, Martinez works as a marketing and creative design consultant. He said that as a consultant from El Paso, he continues to push the boundaries of creativity while staying true to his Hispanic roots and love for his hometown.

Martinez's mural work includes a prominent one on the exterior of the El Paso

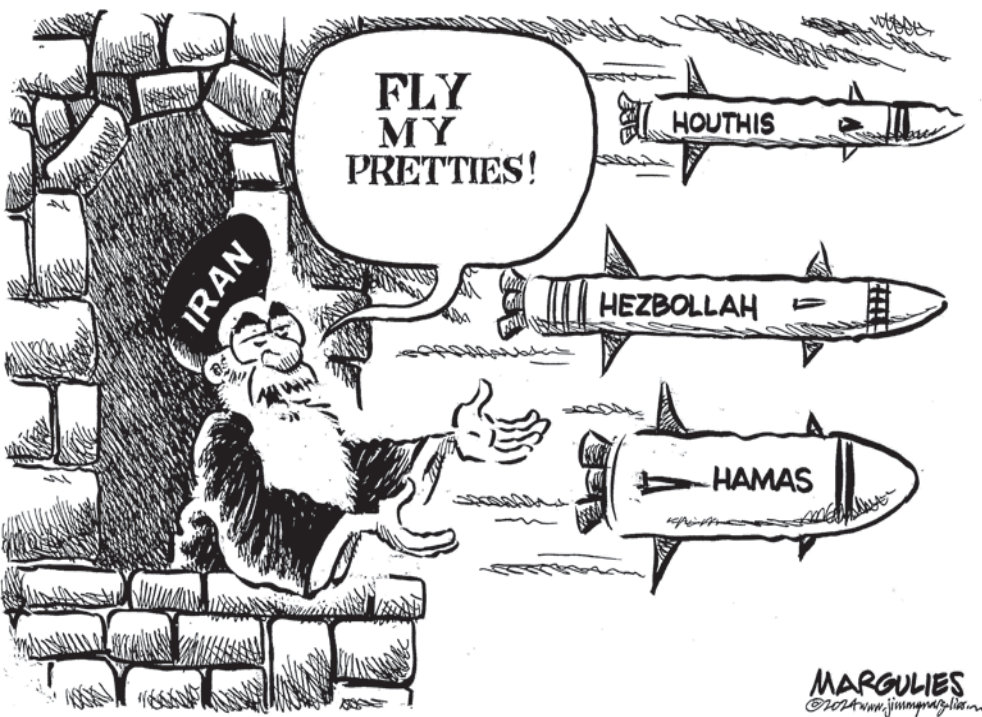
- On Oct. 14, 1947, U.S. Air Force Capt. Chuck Yeager becomes the first person to fly faster than the speed of sound. His X-1 rocket plane was dropped from a B-29 aircraft, rocketed to 40,000 feet and exceeded 662 mph.
- On Oct. 15, 1917, Mata Hari, the seductive female spy, is executed for espionage by a French firing squad. Mata Hari claimed to have been born in a sacred temple, but in reality, the exotic dancer was born Margaretha Geertruida Zelle in Holland.
- On Oct. 16, 1958, Chevrolet begins to sell a car-truck hybrid that it calls the El Camino. The vehicle, a combination sedan-pickup truck built on a station-wagon platform, was discontinued two years later, but was brought back in 1964.
- On Oct. 17, 1931, gangster Al Capone is sentenced to 11 years in prison for tax evasion. Capone had avoided long stints in jail by bribing

city officials and intimidating witnesses, and tax evasion was the only way federal agent Elliot Ness and "The Untouchables" could get him.

- On Oct. 18, 1977, in the sixth game of the World Series, New York Yankees outfielder Reggie Jackson hits three home runs in a row off of three consecutive pitches from three different pitchers. Only Babe Ruth had ever hit three homers in a World Series game, but he didn't do it on consecutive at-bats.
- On Oct. 19, 1987, Black Monday, the Dow Jones Industrial Average experiences its largest-ever one-day percentage decline, plunging 22.6%. Unrelated world events compounded by computer-governed trading conspired to tank global markets.
- On Oct. 20, 1968, American Dick Fosbury wins gold and sets an Olympic high-jump record when he clears 7 feet 4-1/4 inches at the Mexico City Games. It was the international debut of his unique jumping style, known as the "Fosbury Flop."

I don't think so. The way around this – should these types of discussions come to your house via well-meaning others – is to be one step ahead and be very well versed in the typical scams that are aimed at seniors.

In a banking scam, you know not to click any email links or give any information over the phone. You hang

up and call the bank directly to ask if they called you.

In the charity scams, you'll be asked to give money over the phone. Don't do it. If you want to give, send a check directly to the charity.

In the grandparent scam, a fake grandchild will call and say he's in trouble and needs bail money. No, you'll simply hang up.

No, the IRS will never call and insist you make a payment with gift cards.

In the romance scam where a fake online love interest suddenly needs cash, you won't hand over a single dime. Period.

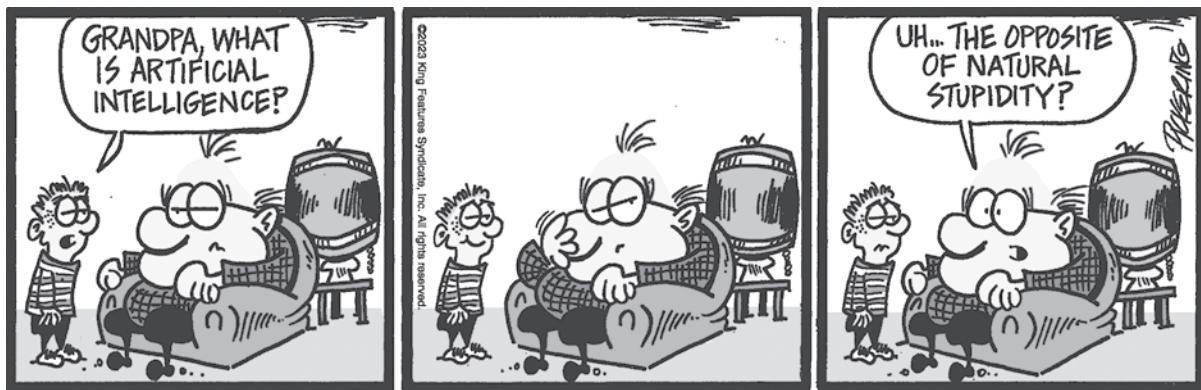

Park officials say, "the birth adds incredibly important genes into the pool of the population, furthering the genetic diversity and health of the Sumatran tiger species." # Cancer treatment may use chemo prior to surgery

**DEAR DR. ROACH:** My husband was diagnosed with ampullary cancer. He has a tumor the size of a marble. We are told this is an aggressive cancer. My concern is that they are giving him chemotherapy before the Whipple surgery. Is this standard practice? – P.T.



The ampulla of Vater is an opening in the duodenum (the first segment of the small intestine), where the common bile duct releases bile and pancreatic enzymes to aid digestion. A cancer of the ampulla can originate from the pancreas, bile duct or duodenum, and these can all be aggressive cancers. The standard approach in people with the possibility to be cured is called a pancreaticoduodenectomy, otherwise known as the Whipple procedure. Although this is a complex surgery that used to have a high mortality rate, the risk of death from the procedure in specialized centers is now about 1%.

Most people are familiar with getting chemotherapy after surgery to help remove any cancer cells that remain, a technique called "adjuvant therapy." However, giving chemotherapy before surgery ("neoadjuvant chemotherapy") has increasingly been used in people with ampullary cancer. The idea is to shrink the tumor to make it easier for the surgeon to remove completely. Chemotherapy may also kill any cancer cells that have already spread.

The decision of when to use chemotherapy depends on the individual's situation, so I can't tell you which would be better in your husband's case, as I lack both the details of his tumor and the expertise. I can confirm that giving chemotherapy prior to surgery is being used in regards to ampullary cancer.

**DEAR DR. ROACH:** I am 22. I had an electrocardiogram (EKG) last year, which indicated an incomplete right bundle branch block and early repolarization of the ventricles. Are these two related to each other? Are they serious to any extent, since I don't have any symptoms? How can my heart rate be normal if the ventricles repolarize early? – B.A.N.

Both early repolarization and an incomplete right bundle branch block are common findings in young people who are getting EKGs, usually as part of a school physical and often as an evaluation for athletes. Depolarization of the heart muscle is seen on the surface electrocardiogram and corresponds to the contraction of the ventricle (called the QRS waves). The muscle cells must then "repolarize" – that is, restore their electrical potential to get ready for the next contraction.

Early repolarization is a normal variant where the ventricle gets electrically ready for the next beat faster than average. In fact, one way to be sure that the EKG finding really does signify early repolarization is to put the person on a treadmill to raise their heart rate. The early repolarization will then go away, since faster repolarization is appropriate for a quicker heartbeat.

About 15% of young athletes with early repolarization will also have an incomplete right bundle branch block, which represents slowing of the electrical impulses within the ventricles and a widening of the QRS complex.

Fortunately, these findings almost never represent serious disease in people without any symptoms.

## Get VA medical info on your iPhone

The Department of Veterans Affairs has partnered with Apple to let us access our health records right from our iPhone. This information will include not only the health care we get from the VA, but from other medical providers as well.

If you've ever looked at the Health app on your iPhone, you've seen that it's comprehensive. With the VA partnership with Apple, you'll be able to look up lab results and check prescriptions, shot records and more, right on your phone.

It will work with third-party apps to keep track of every healthy (or unhealthy) thing you do. It will remind you to take your pills or check your glucose. It will track your sleep cycles and wake you with an alarm. The phone app can even hook up with

an Apple smartwatch and let you know if your heart rate is too fast.

So why does this make me nervous? Let me count the ways.

- You'll need an iPhone to access the Health app. At this writing, the cheapest one [in 2023] is \$450, for an iPhone 8.

- The software will periodically connect your phone to the various medical servers and bring in any new records.

- To keep your medical data safe, you'll need to use Face ID, a passcode or Touch ID, whether or not you want it. Are you certain that no one else knows your passcode?

- The app includes an unencrypted emergency Medical ID card that EMTs (and anyone else) can use to check your health info.

- We don't know that third-party provider apps are safe.

Check your iPhone if you have one. The default setting is to track your walking distance, flights climbed and steps taken.

You might have years of data on your phone without knowing it.

- Got plastic packaging that's a pain to get open? Use your can opener. Run it around the sides to break into your packages. It works!

- Buff spots off of silver with toothpaste. Rub gently with a soft cloth, rinse and dry.

- For every side dish that requires extra preparation time, plan for one or two that don't. For instance, if you are preparing a casserole with many ingredients and complicated instructions, serve a package of vegetables that require nothing more than steaming.

- Wine buyers tip: Experts say to multiply the number of adult guests by a half bottle to determine how many bottles of wine to buy for your holiday gathering. Add an additional glass of wine per guest for every hour after dinner you expect guests to linger.

- How to peel potatoes: Boil whole potatoes with skin on for 20-30 minutes (depending on the size of your potatoes). You should be able to stick a knife all the way through without resistance. Then remove them to an ice bath for 10 seconds each. The skin will slip right off.

- "Have kids make their own whipped cream with a jam jar! Fill a screw-top jar (glass, chilled, works really well) halfway with heavy cream, a little sugar and any flavoring extracts you like, then seal and shake. Kids also can make butter with cream in a jar. You may add a pinch of salt instead of sugar, and shake longer." – A.A. in Florida

- Researchers tell us that the best time to interview is late morning on a Tuesday. You will avoid the interviewer's likely Monday/Friday crunch, and have his or her full attention. Do your homework on the company, and get ready to shine!

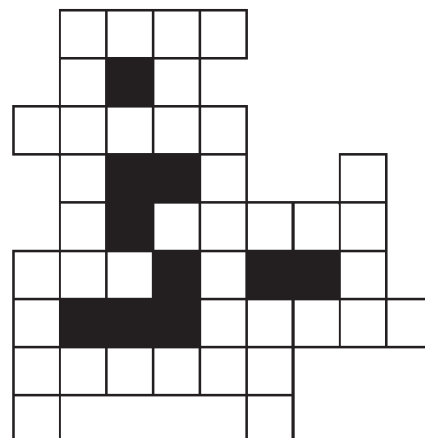
