ANTHONY, TX - Nine Anthony Independent School District teachers have earned additional compensation for their impactful work after meeting the requirements of the Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA) program, a state initiative that rewards educators with significant financial incentives based on student outcomes.

TIA was established during the 86th legislative session through House Bill (HB) 3 to recruit, retain, and reward highly effective teachers. To qualify, school districts must implement a system based on teacher observations and student growth measures. The qualification system must







# **TEA backs Canutillo ISD** for Bean Farm purchase

**CANUTILLO** Texas Education Agency's Compliance Review Unit has cleared the Canutillo

Independent School District in its investigation into the allegation of impropriety in the purchase of the Bean Horse Farm for the construction of the new Canutillo Middle School, the state informed the District in an official statement last week.

Richard Segovia, the TEA's Director of the Special Investigations Division, said the state began an investigation after it received a complaint from a community member.

"After a review of the allegations, evidence and documents received, the TEA Compliance Review Unit (CRU) has determined that the school entity has addressed the reported concern(s) that were within the jurisdiction of TEA and no further actions will be taken at this time," Segovia said in a letter to Canutillo ISD.

The Board of Trustees in December ratified the purchase of the farm by the Administration. Superintendent Dr. Pedro Galaviz signed the contract to buy the land in November, when trustees indicated their support for the acquisition during a board meeting.

Segovia said that as part of the TEA review, which included responses from the District and other documentation, Canutillo ISD showed that it is in compliance with program and/or statutory requirements.

"Canutillo continues to emphasize ethics and community accountability in its efforts to meet the promises we made in the delivery of the Bond projects," Galaviz said. "With this behind us, we can move forward with our plans of using Bond funds to build a world-class facility that will serve the Canutillo Middle School community."

The new \$106-million Canutillo Middle will be built on Bean Farm site at the intersection of Artcraft and Upper Valley roads. Construction is expected to take about three years.



# Moments

- On April 7, 1961, President John F. Kennedy sent a letter to Congress endorsing America's participation in an international campaign to preserve ancient temples and historic monuments in Egypt's Nile Valley. The campaign was initiated by UNESCO with the aim of saving sites threatened by the construction of the Aswan High Dam.
- On April 8, 1994, the body of grunge rocker Kurt Cobain was discovered at his home in Seattle by a workman. The heroin-addicted, troubled artist had died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound, leaving behind rocker Courtney fellow Love, his wife, who had reported him missing, and toddler daughter Frances Bean Cobain.
- On April 9, 1859, 23-yearold writer Samuel Langhorne Clemens received steamboat pilot's license. He navigated his own boats for two years until the Civil War put a halt to steamboat traffic, and in 1861 penned a humorous travel letter signed "Mark Twain," a pseudonym he would continue to use as a popular author for nearly

five decades.

- On April 10, 1975, 41-yearold Lee Elder became the first Black golfer to play in the Masters, considered the sport's most prestigious event. The Professional Golfers' Association, organizer of the main professional tours played by men in North America, hadn't approved participation by African Americans in events it cosponsored until 1952.
- On April 11, 1979, Ugandan dictator Idi Amin fled the capital of Kampala as Tanzanian troops and forces of the Uganda National Liberation Front began to close in. Two days later, Kampala fell and a coalition government of former exiles took power. Amin, who was notorious for his brutality, escaped to Libya and eventually settled in Saudi Arabia, where he died in August 2003.
- On April 12, 1861, the American Civil War began after Confederate forces fired on Fort Sumter in Charleston Harbor, South Carolina.
- On April 13, 1360, a hailstorm killed an estimated 1,000 English soldiers in Chartres. France. One survivor described it as "a foul day, full of mist and hale, so that men died on horseback."

## Grant applications open to regional animal welfare organizations for assistance with essential supplies

EL PASO COUNTY – The El Paso Community Foundation is accepting applications for the new Borderland Rescue Fund. Animal welfare organizations may apply for grants of up to \$1,500 to assist with essential supplies. The Foundation created the Borderland Rescue Fund in response to the increasing number of area animals requiring care in recent years. In 2024, more than 25,000 animals entered shelters and rescues in the El Paso area.

The application process for the Borderland Rescue Fund is simple and straightforward, to allow organizations to focus on their vital work. Animal welfare organizations from the El Paso area, Southern New Mexico, and West Texas are encouraged to apply.

"Staff and volunteers at animal welfare organizations are often overwhelmed, working tirelessly to ensure the well-being of our community's animals," said Tess Passero, program officer with the El Paso Community Foundation. "Our goal is to alleviate some of their burden and show them how much they are valued."

Other key initiatives of the Borderland Rescue Fund include an expanded 15 location Pet Pantry Network, made possible by a partnership with the City of El Paso and its libraries, and a Medical Reserve Fund for injured and sick animals and their rescuers.

"This is a growing need, that we want to address as comprehensively as possible," said Eric Pearson, President and CEO of the Foundation.

The Summerlee Foundation, a Dallas-based organization that supports animal protection and historical preservation in Texas, helped make this grant program possible.







# Floater in man's eye is incredibly distracting

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 67-year-old male with generally good vision. I've had a few floaters in my eyes

over the years, but they have generally been small and have not significantly affected myvision. However, about six months ago, I suddenly had a large floater appear in one of my eyes that did affect my vision. It is right in the center of my field of vision and is very distracting. I had a checkup with my



optometrist soon after, and she said there were no major issues with my eye. She said that my brain would adjust to the floater so I would not notice it as much. However, six months later, I still find it very distracting. I frequently have to move my eye to try and get it out of my center vision so I can see clearly. Are there any treatments that can be done to remove distracting floaters? – D.H.

"Floaters" are bits of cellular debris in the vitreous humor, which is the gel-filled space in between the lens and the retina. The sudden appearance of floaters can represent serious eye disease, such as a detached retina, so it was wise to get an evaluation when you noticed a sudden change.

The eye does not have a way to remove floaters, so you will have them as long as you live unless you do something about it. As your optometrist said, they don't bother most people; however, several of my readers over the years have been so bothered by floaters that they have undergone surgical vitrectomy. This is the removal of all the gel material from the vitreous cavity, including all (or nearly all) of the vitreous opacities that cause floaters. Published complication rates with this procedure are less than 1% in experienced hands.

I have also read about using a laser to break up large floaters into smaller and presumably easier-to-ignore pieces, but I have no personal experience with this. In addition, the literature is mixed.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I was diagnosed with sleep apnea decades ago. While I was not obese, I was a little overweight at the time and made a commitment to eat better. I lost 10-20 pounds, and I'm down to under 250 pounds at 6 feet, I inch tall. Voila, my sleep apnea was cured! I kept the weight off and have not snored since. While you note the connection between excess weight and sleep apnea, I didn't see any mention of weight loss as a cure. Is it really this easy, or was I just lucky? – D.K.

Weight loss is effective at treating sleep apnea in many people. However, losing and keeping the weight off in the long-term is very hard for most people. The GLP-1 drug tirzepatide (Zepbound) was recently approved for obstructive sleep apnea in people who are obese, in combination with a healthy diet and physical activity. GLP-1 agonists are quite effective at helping people lose weight and keeping the weight off (as long as the person keeps taking the medication).

It's critical to note that not everyone with obstructive sleep apnea is obese. Some people just have the anatomy in the back of their throats that makes sleep apnea more likely, despite having a normal weight. Weight loss may not help them at all in these cases.




