Border 'proximity' seals Ft. Bliss in immigration role

EL PASO COUNTY - El Paso County is playing a major role in the U.S. government's latest immigration control policies that are unfolding on Fort Bliss Army Base land.

The local military base has been chosen as a site to detain and house thousands of migrants, and construction of the facilities on the base is underway. Plans are to build a campus that can hold more than 5,000 migrants, according to Army officials.

Fort Bliss is also being developed as a hub for military aircrafts that are being used for deportation flights that are taking migrants to countries including Guatemala, Ecuador, and Honduras, among other destinations.

In addition, Fort Bliss is currently serving as the center where active duty troops, who have been deployed to the border, receive training before moving out to support Customs and

While the facilities will be on US military property, Army personnel, however, will not be manning them due to laws barring military personnel from engaging in law enforcement activity. Earlier reports indicated that ICE awarded the contract to a private company to operate the migrant detention camp on Fort Bliss.

The army base in El Paso County has previously been used to temporarily house migrants including during the surge of unaccompanied migrant children a few years ago. Fort Bliss was also used to house thousands of Afghan nationals during Operation Allies Welcome, an initiative launched to support and resettle more than 11,000 Afghans after the US pulled troops out of Afghanistan in 2021.

El Paso's U.S. Rep Veronica Escobar is voicing concern with the whole situation occurring in her hometown. During a recent oversight hearing held by the House Appropriations subcommittee on homeland security in Washington, D.C., she questioned

conditions of the current detention facilities.

"The increase in cost to taxpayers obviously hasn't I bet it has meant an increase in profit for these private companies," Escobar stated during the hearing. "How many total beds does the reconciliation package create?" she asked the ICE director, referring to

Nursing tradition: A father and son's shared calling

EL PASO COUNTY – The Melendez family knows all too well how the El Paso Community College (EPCC) Nursing program can change lives. Sergio Melendez Sr. graduated from the EPCC Nursing's Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) to Registered Nurse (RN) Program in 1996, and now his son, Sergio Melendez Jr., will followed in his fathers' footsteps, graduating on May 16, 2025 with an Associate Degree of Nursing (ADN) degree from EPCC following the programs' 50th Pinning ceremony on May 15.

CANUTILLO – Canutillo High School student Matthew Medina has earned several impressive titles this year: valedictorian, MITbound scholar, record-setting scholarship recipient – and now, State Champion.

Lyon said that there have been nine deaths in ICE facilities, and promised to update the committee with the available information about the reported deaths.

- On May 26, 1897, Bram Stoker's now iconic novel "Dracula" went on sale in London. Stoker's editors had deleted the first 101 pages of the manuscript and altered the text to seem less "real," since there just so happened to be a serial killer known as Jack the Ripper on the loose in the city at that time.
- On May 27, 1949, the unemployed, 22-year-old model-actress Marilyn Monroe earned \$50 for posing nude for a Los Angeles photographer against a red velvet backdrop. Though it became the most famous calendar photo in history, she never earned another cent from the picture, as she had signed away all her rights to it in a release form.
- On May 28, 2005, Carl Roland, Edward was wanted by police in connection with the murder of his ex-girlfriend Jennifer Gonzalez, was removed from a crane perched 18 stories above a construction site in Atlanta, where he'd spent three days. 

Olive oil has health benefits over other oils

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 76-year-old male in good health. I go to the gym three days a week, eat well, and fast one day

a week. I have been reading about taking a tablespoon of olive oil at night as a remedy for all kinds of things such as digestion issues and arthritis. I tried it, and I swear that the first day after ingesting it, I felt less pain in the arthritis in my hands and feet. Is there any evidence that this practice is helpful? Also,



does it matter what kind or brand of olive oil one uses? I bought special olive oil that is polyphenol-rich; it is lighter and more tasty than the extra-virgin oil I normally buy at the food market. What's your take on this? -L.A.

Although I don't think olive oil is a cure for all ailments, there are certainly health benefits when using olive oil compared to most oils. The flavor and amount of polyphenol (an anti-inflammatory compound found in olive oil) will vary from one brand to another. These antiinflammatory compounds can help symptoms of arthritis in some people.

Personally, I recommend extra-virgin olive oil (made from the initial squeezing of olives without chemical and heat treatment), which has the highest amount of the nutrients you want. But my advice is to choose based on the flavor you like and how much you want to spend rather than the polyphenol content. And of course, too much of anything, including olive oil, isn't good for you, but a tablespoon is fine.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I came down with a headache, but nothing showed up after a year of tests, including a CT scan, MRIs, and a spinal tap. Then I was told that I had a nummular headache, which I understand is rare. I have a sore spot in the back of my head and a feeling in my head that I just can't explain. I don't know how I made it through a year until I got on meds. I am now taking 25 mg of lamotrigine a day. I'm at the point where I'll have a couple good days, then it comes back. Can this be cured? Is the medication that I'm taking OK, or is there something better? – K.S.

A nummular headache (the name comes from the Latin word for coin as the sore spot is often the size and shape of a coin) is very uncommon, and I've never treated a case. I would defer treatment to a neurologist with expertise in headaches.

Gabapentin is a common treatment, but lamotrigine is also used. The best treatment is the one that works best for you. Although sometimes the condition will simply go away, it often doesn't, requiring chronic medication to keep symptoms under control.

I will note that you are on a tiny dose of lamotrigine. It needs to be started at a small dose, but when used for seizures, the usual dose is 400-600 mg per day (which takes several weeks to reach, titrating slowly). If it's working for you but not well enough, you might do better with a higher dose.

If a higher dose doesn't work, there are other medications to try such as antidepressants like amitriptyline and other seizure medications like carbamazepine. One other option to ask your neurologist about is botulinum toxin (Botox), which relieves pain by more than half in about two-thirds




